- d. Before starting construction above the MBE, the landowner or builder shall supply the municipal Development Officer with a plan showing the top of any concrete pads, grade beams, piles or foundation walls to be located above the MBE.
- 2. That all structures (including decks) be located at least 10' from the front property line.
- 3. That the applicant provide the RM planner a plan signed by a Saskatchewan Land Surveyor meeting item (1)(d) above prior to any landscaping or construction.
