New Business

Corey reported back from Rm /Hamlet meeting held Oct 22 concerning topics that are of interest to Evergreen:

- Snow removal insurance for anyone that may be using their own equipment, that they should be insured. We will continue to use Paul Hamm that has all proper insurance and equipment that fits in our hamlet.
- CSO reported that 2025 was a teaching year, they will be enforcing more in 2026
- Fire Smart Grant is available for hamlets to increased emergency preparedness. Perhaps we can do more education to residents and perhaps develop a location for emergency helicopter landing.
- Water Securities, Corey spoke that there is concern in Maintaining and managing lake levels.
 Perhaps we can encourage water securities to maintain water level gate that is located at South Bay.
- Corey will work on Capital Expense plan asap

Sask Power clean-up is ready to be done they (Sask Power rep) has contacted residents that will be affected and they will work together so, job get done and residents are satisfied with how trees are dealt with.

Break INS around lake were discussed. Is there anything else we can do? Just keep eyes open and report any activity.
